The Harleian Society was founded in 1869 for publishing manuscripts of the heraldic visitations of the counties of England and Wales and other manuscripts relating to genealogy, armory and heraldry in the widest sense. Its volumes have always proved to be of great value to genealogists and those interested in family history. It has a world-wide subscribership.

Publications can either be obtained through annual subscription, currently £25 (US\$50) for individuals and £30 (US\$60) for institutions, or purchased at £35 (US\$70) each including postage and packing, except for some recent volumes which are more expensive (see below).

As an introductory bonus, new subscribers can choose free, any one of the recent publications still in print. (*The Visitation of Suffolk 1561* is in two parts: either part i or part ii may be chosen as the free volume. Due to its value *The Visitation of London begun in 1687* is not part of this offer.)
